



Tape this horizon line to your wall at eye-level

Scene 1

Hold in mouth:

- a bird
- a ticking watch
- a water balloon
- chrysoprase (for invisibility)
- someone's tongue, soft, not kissing

Scene 2

Scenes for body-horizon lines:

one:

walking into a store. (rest your head on the shoulder of the person in front of you)

two:

doctors office?. (would you like to lie your arm in here? your hands look cold. my side is warm)

three:

on the bus (electric hairs on the shoulder that caress the neck of whoever sits next to you)

four:

two walk to a flat landscape. one lies down, stretched out, the other lies on top of them. the stripes in their clothes press into them. a type of stratified weight pushing them into their horizontal compression.

five:

wind relations. clothes that the wind can get in and caress. pockets which hold the wind against you. areas that let it caress past.

six:

locker room shower. swim cap. (fold one ear forward one back). allow water to fall over your skullcap. close eyes.

Scene 3

Velocities & Lines

- the rate at which gravity re-enters the body as water
- drains out of the tub
- a walk from here to there
- water in a garden hose
- a kiss, the transfer of heat and saliva
- face in neck, smell of skin into nose
- the edge of the road
- the edge of a table or desk
- the windowsill of my car
- an overpass

Scene 4

- kiss
- sink
- swim

Scene 5

Other horizon lines (Lines that caress)

- water draining out of a bathtub
- gravity slipping into your body in shifts
- is there a mathematical equation that can tell me at what rate gravity rises into my body?
- the water that traces your contours as it drains, tickling and itching little corners and crevices
- tongue in mouth

Scene 6

- bathtub
- instrument panel
- notes on air

Scene 7

Send you eye on a journey across your arm, away from you

- clothing or sheet wrinkles (hills/dunes/mountains)
- the swell of your shoulder (a hike)
- the hairs on your arm (weeds/trees/forests)
- over your fingers (boulders)
- where rays of sun fall (deserts)

Scene 8

- place
 - immerse
 - integrate
 - disintegrate
 - dissolve
 - disperse
 - condense
- (start over again)
